



ASL's COVID What Do I Do

I have **tested positive for COVID-19**. What do I do?

1. Do not come to campus.
2. Email [Abigail Wescott and Sandy Baker](#) stating that you have **tested positive for COVID-19**.
3. Fill out the [COVID-19 Positive Form](#).
4. Stay in Isolation for **seven days** starting the day after your **positive COVID-19 test** was administered.
5. You may return back to ASL's campus at **day eight** if your COVID-19 symptoms have stopped or improved and you are feeling well enough to be back in-person for class or work. If you are needing to quarantine for longer than seven days, you **must** contact Abigail Wescott directly.

**After you have completed the steps 1-4 above, it is not necessary to receive a response or confirmation to begin attending classes online. The same rules apply after contacting Ms. Wescott if a quarantine extension is needed.



ASL's COVID What Do I Do

I am **currently experiencing possible COVID-19 symptoms**. What do I do?

1. Take a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.
2. If positive, follow the steps in the "**I have tested positive for COVID-19. What do I do?**" document.

If negative, please continue attending in-person classes. If you continue experiencing symptoms three days after your COVID-19 test, we strongly suggest retesting. If at that time you test positive, follow the steps in the "**I have tested positive for COVID-19. What do I do?**" document.

**After you have completed the steps 1 and 2 above, it is not necessary to receive a response or confirmation to begin attending classes online. The same rules apply after contacting Ms. Wescott if a quarantine extension is needed.
