

## PRESS RELEASE

The Buchanan County, Virginia Board of Supervisors on April 14, 2020 adopted an emergency ordinance providing regulations to prevent the spread of a contagious disease, namely COVID-19. The ordinance includes a provision restricting travel by out-of-county residents into Buchanan County in section 3(H). That provision has been modified to read as follows:

Travel by out of county residents into Buchanan County is not permitted beyond 24 hours, except for the three following exceptions: 1) employment purposes; 2) for educational purposes, namely in regard to the Appalachian School of Law and the Appalachian College of Pharmacy; and 3) invitation by a county resident for family purposes.
